The Department of Public Health (DPH) and Mayor's Office on Disability (MOD) are working to ensure vaccination appointments are accessible and available to people with disabilities. A number of initiatives are underway. The goal is to make sure that every person with a disability has opportunities to be vaccinated.

Live In-Person ASL interpretation is currently scheduled for Friday, April 30, 2021 at Lighthouse for the Blind Vaccination Clinic: 1155 Market St. Appointments can be booked through the Vaccine Call Center <u>628-652-2700</u>.

Lighthouse for the Blind provides dedicated services for the people with blindness/low vision, and the vaccine clinic welcomes all people with disabilities and their caregivers.

This clinic runs every Friday through May 7. ASL Interpretation is provided remotely on other clinic days.

Additionally, ASL video remote interpreting is currently provided at the <u>Moscone Center</u>, <u>SF Market</u>, and <u>City College</u> high volume vaccine sites.

The vaccine call center <u>628-652-2700</u> is available to any person with a disability to assist with information on vaccine availability and help with appointment scheduling.
