Dear Arc Participants, Families and Circles of Support,

It is difficult to believe that we have now passed the one-year anniversary since our campus doors closed in response to COVID-19. Though we have not been on campus, our community has continued to connect, learn and grow. As the public health emergency continues to improve, we look forward to serving our participants in new ways.

#### **Phased Reopening:**

- Phase 1, Essential and Distanced 1:1 Support of our reopening plan continues with more staff returning. For the past 15 months and with health and safety in mind, we have had over 80 staff members in the field supporting our participants in residential, wellness, job coaching, and education programs. Our robust remote learning platform continued to grow and allow our participants to connect safely and continue working towards their goals. During this time, The Arc also prioritized staff vaccination, and we are happy to report that over 70% of our staff have been vaccinated.
- Phase 2 We anticipate moving into Phase 2, Small Community Based Groups, by May 1st, 2021. During this time, we will be increasing our 1:1 community-based inperson supports and introducing small classes and group outings based on participant needs and geography. We will continue the increase of in-person service with a target to reopen our campuses on a limited basis in the Fall for hybrid services. All program planning will be person-centered and done in partnership with our participants and their circles of support as needed. We will move forward with a high level of flexibility as we have done over these past 15 months centering the health and safety of both our participants and staff. Participants with increased support needs or those who are not best served remotely will be prioritized for in-person supports. We will continue to follow the strict guidelines put forward by both our local and state departments of public health, as well as following best practices for supporting individuals with disabilities. Our robust remote learning offerings will continue through our phased reopening plan.
- Campus Reopening In alignment with our community colleges, The Arc San Francisco
  anticipates reopening our campuses for in-person services at a limited capacity starting
  in the Fall. Return to our campuses will not be required, and all planning will be focused
  on participant needs and the best environment to provide supports. We will continue to
  follow the most conservative guidance from our local and state departments of public
  health as well as best practices for serving individuals with disabilities as our
  communities continue to reopen.

## **Vaccination Priority**

Vaccination access for all adults over the age of 16 in California began on 4/15/2021. The vaccination process can still be challenging to navigate, so we have updated resource pages on both our Arc SF <u>website</u> and our participant <u>ArcSF Hub</u>. We are excited about the opportunities that vaccination brings for our entire community, but recognize that it is a personal health choice for all participants and staff. We are providing advocacy and resources to ensure that all of our community members have the information they need to make informed decisions about vaccination.
