

## Health Advocacy/Wellness

- 1,731 Interventions

One-to-one case management is provided for: Clinician visits, age-appropriate health screenings, vision care, dental health, podiatry, fitness, nutrition, protective advocacy and medication monitoring.

## Housing & Residential Services

- 58 Participants receiving independent living support and housing advocacy

Participants are supported in shopping, nutritious meal preparation, budgeting and financial management, neighbor relations and healthy relationships, as well as qualifying and applying for new housing situations, moving and settling in to new residences.
